Mark Wills added the work with existing industry/workforce development and talent recruitment should be seen as a high priority. Robbie Bennett commented that the value of existing industry can be seen by the \$100 million in expansions between 3 companies. Committee functions and operation priorities within missions of DACC were outlined. Robbie Bennett stated that he would like to structure DACC to be an Accredited Economic Development organization in the future.
